

2 POLYMER CLAY CLASSES WITH THE NZ POLYMER CLAY SUPREMA ~ PETRA

Button Magic– Polymer clay is a medium that has its place in many artists and crafters workboxes. Have you ever made a beautiful creation only to find that you cannot buy that one last embellishment it needs to finish it off? Or, you create a garment to wear and you just can't find the right button or closure you need to complete it. In this intensive workshop you will learn some polymer clay techniques that will enable you to create unique pieces. We will focus on buttons and closures using techniques such as working with moulds, rubber-stamping onto the clay, and creating simple millefiori canes. You will learn how to make shapes and incorporate attachment methods in this workshop. Although the main focus today will be on buttons, toggles and closures, you will be able to use the techniques you learn in many other ways. **Cost: \$65 plus materials**

Embellish with Polymer clay – This workshop is a follow-on to the Saturday workshop. It is not essential that you have attended the Saturday workshop although some familiarity with Polymer clay would be useful. Using similar techniques to the Saturday class, the process will be developed further and we will focus more on larger, more dramatic pieces, intended for use on garments, quilts and any other of your textile or craft projects. Techniques included in this class will be layering with metallic clays, using Stamplets and Shapelets and skinner blending with coloured clays. (Skinner blending is a technique that allows for a smooth transition from one colour to another in a sheet of clay.) **Cost: \$65 plus materials**
